



New survey: 60% of Irish exporters think Brexit would harm their business

A survey of Irish Exporters Association (IEA) members has found that 60% think that a Brexit would harm their business, while 78% think it would be bad for the Irish economy and 84% think it would be bad for Irish export business as whole. IEA Chief Executive Simon McKeever said fears of a Brexit were already damaging Irish exporters over the past few weeks – with a 10.5% appreciation in the value of the euro against the pound proving particularly harmful.
