The Irish Exporters Association (IEA) is an independent representative body for the whole spectrum of companies within the export industry, from small and medium enterprises (SMEs) that are considering exporting for the first time right through to global multinational companies. The IEA is the connecting force for Irish exporters, providing practical knowledge and support for members to grow their exports to world markets. The IEA does this through:

- Representation – leading the export agenda as the voice of Irish exporters through policy, lobbying and intervention at Government level;
- Member development – enhancing the export knowledge and skill set of members through a range of training services and export development programmes;
- Networking and connectivity – connecting its members with Government and business stakeholders domestically and in market;
- Export services – enabling its members with practical assistance and critical support services.

The IEA's Consular Services Department can assist EU and non-EU nationals who have an Irish residency stamp in obtaining business and tourist visas. They also assist with the legalisation of documents for export: through the relevant chambers, notaries public, embassies and the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade.
